



# Scholarship and Internship Opportunities with NOAA



The National Oceanic and Atmospheric Administration (NOAA) provides scholarship and internship opportunities in the Pacific Islands and throughout the U.S. for high school and college students who are interested in or currently pursuing degrees and careers that support NOAA's programs and mission.

## Scholarships

### ***EPP/MSI Undergraduate Scholarship***

Provides two years of funding for academic assistance and includes two, paid summer internships with NOAA

Eligibility: Rising college juniors that attend an accredited minority serving institution, minimum 3.2 GPA

### ***Ernest F. Hollings Scholarship Program***

Provides two years of funding for academic assistance and includes a paid, summer internship with NOAA

Eligibility: Rising college juniors that attend an accredited U.S. or U.S. territories institution, minimum 3.0 GPA

### ***Dr. Nancy Foster Scholarship***

Provides graduate student funding, particularly to woman and minorities, pursuing a degree related to the mission of NOAA's Office of National Marine Sanctuaries

Eligibility: Pursue or intend to pursue a graduate degree in a marine science related field at a U.S. accredited institution, minimum 3.3 GPA

### ***National Coral Reef Management Fellowship***

Two-year program that provides fellows with professional experience in coastal and coral reef resource management

Eligibility: Applicants typically have a bachelor's and four years experience or a master's and two years experience

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## Internships

### ***Pacific Islands Fisheries Science Center (PIFSC) Young Scientist Opportunity***

Paid, summer internship with NOAA PIFSC that provides job training, research experience and mentorship

Eligibility: Must be a full-time, undergraduate at an accredited college or university, minimum 3.0 GPA in a major or study that supports NOAA's program and mission

### ***Office of Ocean Exploration and Research (OER) Explorer-in-Training Program***

Provides hands-on experience in ocean exploration and mapping aboard the NOAA Ship *Okeanos Explorer*

Eligibility: Open to undergraduate/graduate students who are currently enrolled or recently graduated, interest in learning about seafloor mapping operations

### ***Significant Opportunities in Atmospheric Research and Science (SOARS)***

Paid, summer program geared towards under-represented minorities to conduct research at the National Center of Atmospheric Research (NCAR)

Eligibility: Non-graduating undergraduates majoring in atmospheric science, or a related field such as geosciences, engineering, oceanography or mathematics, plan to pursue a career in science
